los - the - masculine - plural (more than one)

un - a - masculine - singular

una - a - feminine - singular

unos - some - masculine - plural

unas - some - feminine - plural

How can we spot a masculine noun?

How can we spot a masculine noun?

"O" on the end
un or el before it

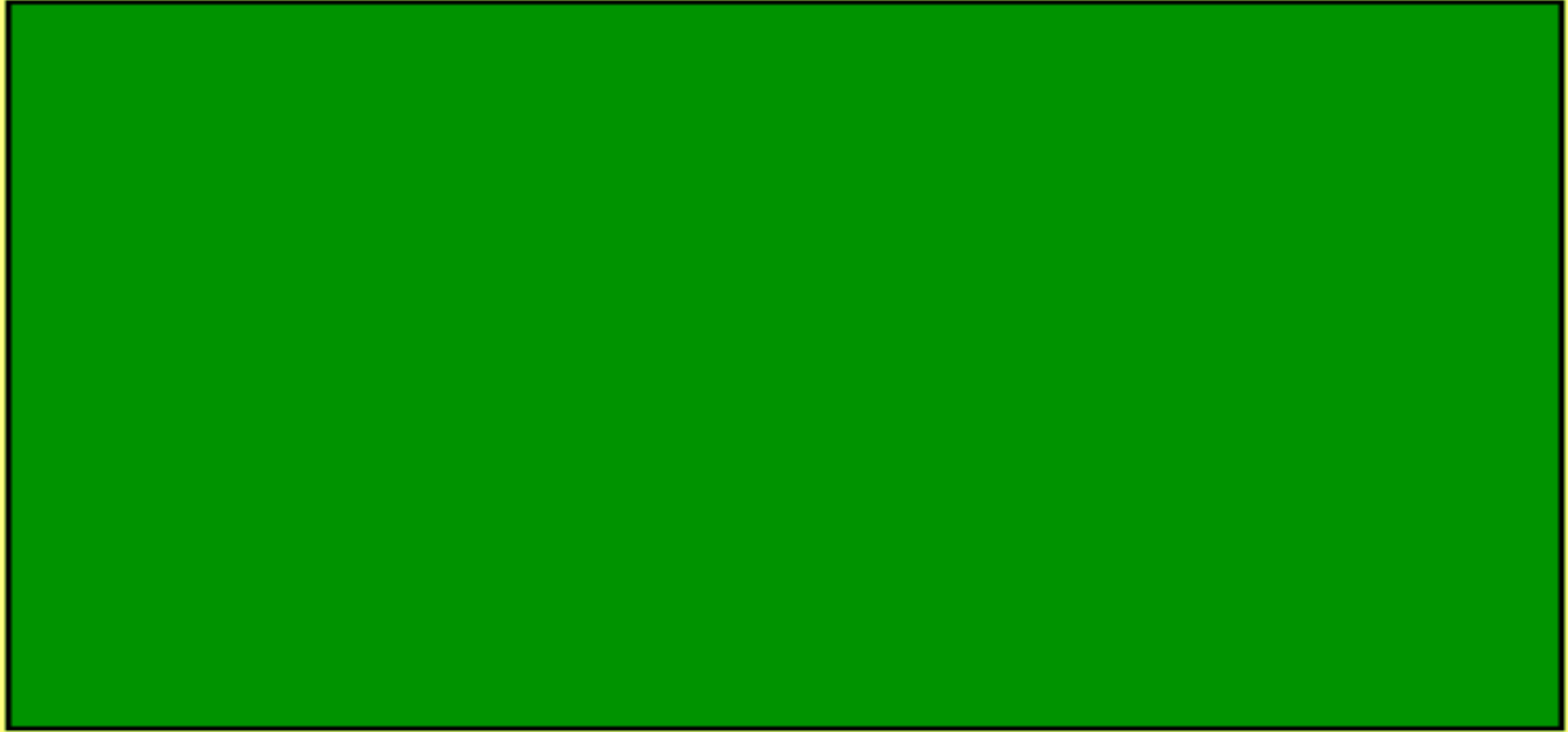
How can we spot a feminine noun?

"a" on the end
una or la before it

How can we spot a plural noun?

"S" or "es" on the end
los, las, unos, unas or a number before it

How do we add adjectives correctly?



How do we add adjectives correctly?

If the adjective ends in "O" (Like rojo)
change the "O" to "a" - (feminine singular)
"as" - (feminine plural)

If they end in "e" (like verde)
add "S" for each plural form

If they end in a consonant (like azul)
add "es" for each plural form
