Class Liturgies

All classes held their class Prayer liturgies last week. The children devise these liturgies themselves. At the end of each four week topic they are given the opportunity to reflect on what they have learnt and to celebrate the topic in the form of a liturgy. The children are prompted to consider what they want to include in their liturgy using their Respond booklets. These reminds them to think about prayers, Scripture quotes, responses and music they might want to include. They choose everything; even the organisation of how they are arranged. In Year 6 Nwuabeze decided that the children should sit in the shape of a heart, because their topic had been 'Loving'. Year 5 decided that they wanted to include the 'Footprints Poem', because they had been looking at how God loved them in their 'Ourselves' topic. These are a lovely opportunity for the children to spend time raising their minds and hearts to God.
