Horniman Museum Trip – 13th November 2025

To support our current ancient Egypt topic, we have arranged for a visit to the Horniman Museum. The children will participate in a workshop which will enhance and bring to life the topic. These workshops are a great learning opportunity as the children can handle artefacts with knowledgeable specialists who will answer questions about them.

The children will need to be in school at the usual time of 8:30am for registration and will be finishing and returning to school before 3pm. We will be travelling to and from the venue by public transport.

A packed lunch will be required for the day (**no glass bottles and nuts**) in a backpack or string back so it's comfortable for them. Children must be in full school uniform including their school coat. If your child is entitled to benefit related free school meals please inform the school office by Monday 10th November 2025.

Although there is no travelling cost for the children, there is a cost of £4.26 for the workshop. We ask for a voluntary contribution from parents for £4.26 towards the cost of this trip. Payment will be available through Parentpay.
