Re: 'Croydon Wars'

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are aware that some other local primary schools have shared the information below, and we feel it is appropriate to pass this on to you. Please note that this is **information only** for primary schools.

We believe it is important to maintain a balance between keeping families informed and avoiding unnecessary alarm. At this time, this is being shared for awareness only.

We have been advised of social media posts currently circulating among students across several boroughs which appear to place certain schools on opposing "sides". At present, there is no intelligence to suggest any planned violence or organised disorder. However, the situation is being monitored, and schools have been informed at an early stage as a precaution.

Staff have been made aware so they can monitor pupil behaviour, discourage the sharing of these posts, and report any concerns. Duty staff will remain particularly vigilant during arrival and dismissal times. Schools have been advised not to circulate the material directly to students.

If you have any safeguarding concerns or relevant information, this can be passed to your local Neighbourhood Policing Team, via 101, or anonymously through Crimestoppers.
