Yr2 Trip to Morden Hall Park

St Martha's class will be visiting **Morden Hall Park** on Friday 15th May 2026. They will be taking part in a 'Growing Plants' session which will be led by members of the National Trust. During this session, the children will be identifying wild plants in the park and investigating what they need to be able to grow. The purpose of this trip is to support their learning in their current science topic 'Roots and Shoots'.

We will be travelling by train and tram to Morden Hall Park. Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch to school on the day of the trip (no nuts please), if you are in receipt of benefit related free school meals and would like to order a school packed lunch, please inform the school office by Monday 11th May 2026. Your child will need to dress appropriately for the weather. Due to the practical nature of the trip, we would like the children to wear their full PE kit. I also recommend that they have a sunhat and have had suntan lotion applied as well as a full refillable water bottle.

The cost of the trip is £6.20 per child, and we ask for a voluntary donation from each family to cover the cost. Please pay this via ParentPay account by Monday 11th May 2026.
