

Mathematics: Fractions and Money

Year 3 will be continuing to develop their understanding of fractions. We will be adding and subtracting fractions as well finding fractions of an amount. We will then be working with money and using our skills of addition and subtraction and applying this to money we use in our lives today. We will begin to look at time towards the end of this half term where we will be focusing on 5 minute intervals. Children should continue to recall their basic number recall and develop their mental methods for addition and subtraction.

Children will be tested weekly on their knowledge of multiplications and are strongly advised to practice daily.

Understanding English, Communication & Languages

In English, we will be focusing our learning on the book of Escape from Pompeii. We will be developing our story retelling, descriptive writing, debating skills amongst other literacy techniques.

We will also have a weekly grammar focus in line with the national curriculum which will generally coincide with the English homework.

The children will also be developing their comprehension skills through our guided reading sessions and some whole class comprehension skills activities.

Religious Education

We will be continuing to follow the Come and See Scheme and our topic title will be Energy where we will be thinking about the events that occur during Pentecost.

RSE

The children will be focusing on how God loves us in our differences. They will cover the emotional, social and spiritual aspects of this topic.

PSHE

In PSHE we have a topic focus on 'Being my Best'. The children will think about how they can be the best version of themselves. We will also make some links to national initiatives that occur during the Summer Term.
